Highlights of 2024-2025 Term

DAID Staff and Trustee continue to participate in meetings for:

<u>Hatzic Watershed Stewardship Team</u>- FVRD, Leq'a:mel First Nations, City of Mission, various provincial ministries and Urban Systems. A draft governance model is near completion and public engagement is expected in the next few months.

<u>Emergency Flood Risk Mitigation Program</u> – a 2-year government funded program re: creek sediment removal and bank restoration. In 2023 Associated Engineering completed work in Carratt, Patterson, and Davies Creeks. In 2024 work continued on creeks in the Hatzic Prairie area.

<u>IAF Funding: Investment Agriculture Foundation (IAF)</u> – IAF awarded \$5million in funding to the partnership of Leq'a:mel First Nations and DAID. The funding included \$300,000 for the Hatzic Flood Mitigation and Watershed Master Plan, aka Flood Management Plan, and \$4.7m for pump house upgrades and raising electric kiosk station.

Flood Mitigation Plan: Leq'a:mel First Nations is working with Associated Engineering and Urban Systems on this project. An <u>Open House</u> to obtain public input to guide the development of the Flood Mitigation Plan is planned for the <u>Hatzic Area community on April 23, 2025 @ 6:30pm at Hatzic Prairie Hall</u> and for the <u>Leq'a:mel community April 24 @ 5:30pm at Leq'a:mel Development Corporation's boardroom</u>.

**Pumphouse Upgrade project:** DAID's operation manager, Dave Scott, is working closely with Associated Engineering throughout the design and permitting process and will continue as the project progresses. Draft time line is for completion planned for December 2025.

<u>Short Term Use of Water Application</u> - to use slide gates at the pump station to maintain a lake level of 2.5masl from June 25 to September 6, 2025 has been submitted and we have received a confirmation of a tracking number.

<u>UBC & Resilient Waters</u> – 3year project to review and test local pumps for fish friendliness will continue monitoring and running tests at DAID pumpstation for the second year.

If you want to keep up with what DAID is working on you are welcome to attend DAID Trustee meetings that are open to the public. These meeting are held at Hatzic Prairie Hall and meeting dates are published two weeks in advance in the local newspaper and on DAIDs website <a href="https://www.daidinfo.com">www.daidinfo.com</a>.
