- Pointed out loose floating dock on lake is getting close to culverts with recent wind storms.
- Truck had gained access to dyke, tracked it down and advised driver to leave area immediately or they would be locked in.

- Past Due reminder Notices – mailed out October 15, 2025.
- Outstanding taxes amount to \$94,447 with \$13,106 of that amount being delinquent.
